Circa 1890	Arenac Grocery. Alex Monroe standing near doorway with dog. Moore was father of Ina Bay Monroe, recorded as "the first child born in Arenac Township." Another man with dog, unidentified. Two story building with 3 children at an upper story street-facing window. Legible storefront signs for Elwood Fences, Sherwin-Williams Paints and Lisk's. Unknown	Old Arenac Twp School. Date unknown. Wood vertical board building, wood bell tower, two front entrances. Grace Payea Pearsall, teacher. Unknown	Perkins School Class. Date unknown. Children grouped in front of school: 6 boys sitting on fence, appears to be 4 adults and 15 children (1 partial showing at left). The school was located approximately in the center of Arenac Twp.
