Unknown	Michigan Central Railroad station, Alger. Date unknown. During late 1800's, the station served as junction point for the Detroit, Bay City & Alpena Railroad (later became the Detroit & Mackinac Railway). This station rated a trackside standpipe locomotive water pipe. The norm was for the train to pull up to the tower so having a standpipes was unusual for a small place like Alger.	img-moffatt-twp- yyyy-mcr-station.jpg
Unknown	DBCA RR Train on High Iron Bridge. Detroit, Bay City and Alpena Railroad Company train riding High Iron Bridge over the wooden bridge spanning the Rifle River. High Iron Bridge was completed in 1883 using a design patterned from bridge engineering developed in the Civil War.
