1911	Thomas Turner's Hay Barn Destroyed by Tornado. Located just north of Melita in Section 27, the barn was built in 1903 and is said to have been 60' x 160' (9600 sq ft) & 60' tall. Barn flattened. 3 children seated on top face of fallen cupola, woman with baby and child at side seated at the bottom. Only known photo of the wreckage.
